COUNCIL REVIEW OF FACILITIES

This community built the Wagstaffe Hall and has raised funds to upgrade it over the years as well as having a team of community volunteers who manage the Hall, carry out maintenance, and generally keep an eagle eye on what is happening. We operate the Hall under licence from the Council, just as we operate and manage the tennis court under licence from Council, again with the help of a team of volunteers.

Council has advised us that it is reviewing its facilities policy and approaches. Two members of the committee will be attending one of their workshops to be held on 3 April (with another held in Wyong later), to discuss amongst other things policy, fees, charges, tenant and Council maintenance obligation, tenure and customer service.

They are telling us that at the end of phase one, new charges will be introduced, and after that Phase 2 of the review will look at the distribution of facilities and assess what will be needed for the future and possible opportunities for 'co-location, whatever that means! So there may be lots of changes in the pipeline, and clearly, we want to retain our community hall at Wagstaffe for community use, and to have minimal costs. So please support us in this endeavour. We'll keep you posted on progress. It's all about community use of the hall - see below.

Killy Cares - Free Services and Training

Killy Cares continues to help people in our community who are in need – especially those who need help with meals, transport and visiting. The support our volunteers generously provide is all completely free to members of our local community. We are aware there is a misconception that to get help from Killy Cares you need to be a member – you do NOT need to be a member of Killy Cares to receive help.

Also, because some people are reluctant sometimes to ask for help, we encourage everyone (member or not) to look out for others and to ask them if you can refer them to Killy Cares.

The training we provide for people in our community is also free. We have already sponsored CPR and first aid training for nearly 100 locals. Our next free St John CPR-First Aid Course will be on Wednesday 8 May from 9.30am-1.00pm. Training in CPR and the use of AEDs provides life-saving skills as well as the confidence to intervene should an occasion arise when you could help save someone's life. Direct from New York City, The Lucky Bee restaurant & bar has opened in Hardys Bay at 60 Araluen Drive. Killcare locals, Chef Matty Bennett (formally Longrain Sydney) and Rupert Noffs, are thrilled to open their sister restaurant which has been operating from Frankie's Rooftop in Woy Woy since June last year. After their 7 year stint in NYC; they decided on a sea change and to be closer to family.

The Lucky Bee serves seasonal, Southeast Asian street-food. Dishes include Red Prawn Curry (with over 20 ingredients all house-made) and Bao Buns with twice-cooked pork-hock, hoisin, pickled cucumber and chili that were a favourite of Barbra Streisand.

Whilst waiting on their liquor license The Lucky Bee Hardys Bay will be strictly BYO and will charge \$20 per table corkage. 50% of all corkage fees will be donated to the Bouddi Foundation for the Arts supporting young artists.
