MORE VANDALISM at the TENNIS COURT

On Thursday night February 23rd the shade cloth was torn away from the northern tennis court fence at Turo Park, Pretty Beach. This dark green shade cloth, in excellent condition, was installed some 18 months ago because tennis players had problems with the reflection from the sun bouncing off the ripples in the bay. The cloth has been most successful during the thousand times the court was used last year.

The shade cloth was 2m high by 20m long, so it would have been bulky and not easily removed from the immediate area.

Or if the person or people involved are having second thoughts, we'd be glad to have the shade cloth returned - and to understand the reasons why it was removed. The shade cloth will be replaced in the near future.

Turo Park: Following a meeting with staff of Central Coast Council we are delighted that they have responded so promptly to our concerns, so that a trial **soccer goal** is now installed in Turo Park. We hope, of course, that everyone using it will respect the other park users and the tennis court users.

We have also been assured that action will be taken to fill park hollows that hold water and remain boggy for long periods following heavy rain.

Jet Skis: Many community members have expressed concern about the increasing intrusion of jet skis disrupting peaceful enjoyment of our waterways and foreshores. Lobster Beach, where there are often young children and kayakers in the water, is of particular concern with some riders becoming rude and threatening when approached.

WTKCA has written to government ministers requesting that jet skis be banned from landing in National Parks (e.g. Lobster Beach) and that riders be required to conform to a code of behaviour which recognises the rights of others to peaceful enjoyment of beaches.
