NEW SEASON FOR KILLCARE SURF CLUB – FLAGS UP on SATURDAY 28th SEPTEMBER

A new season will soon start for the Surf Club and promises to be a busy one.

Last season saw a dip in significant rescues at 8, down from 32 the previous season. With 38 First Aids (mostly cuts/abrasions and stings but we had spinal injuries requiring hospital attendance), 428 Preventative actions, over 22,000 beach goer attendances and 652 recorded rips while on patrol. Our patrollers put in close to 4,000 hours in total patrol time.

President's Notes

Council elections will be held this month, on Saturday 14 September. The local polling place will be Wagstaffe Hall. Pre-polling in our Ward (Gosford East) will be available at Erina (Erina Trust Community Hall) and Terrigal (CWA Hall). There are others in other Wards in the LGA which you can find on the Elections NSW website. All votes need to be cast within the LGA, so you couldn't do a remote vote from Sydney, say. Postal voting is available if you are away.

We will be voting for 3 councillors to represent our Ward. 12 candidates have put themselves forward for consideration. The majority are Independent, but we have a block of 3 Labor and 2 Liberal as well. Some candidates have had prior roles in local government (the old Gosford Council) and one as a past Federal MP. The rest are new to the prospect of representing us. All should be thanked for putting their hands up.

As a means for them to introduce themselves to us, all candidates for our Ward have been invited to a "Meet the Candidates" event at Wagstaffe Hall on Saturday 7 September, 2pm. Almost all have accepted the invitation so far, which is pleasing to see. Candidates will be asked to provide a statement of their interest in representing us and any particular focus they may have. The audience will be free to pose questions and there will be the opportunity to chat with the candidates in person at the end of the event. The event is not intended to be a debate.

At the election, there will also be a referendum question as to whether you would prefer to see a smaller number of councillors effective from 2028, with a revised Ward structure. There is a brief pro vs con on Council's website which is worth reading in advance. One point worth noting is that whatever the number of councillors, all of them vote on matters before Council. Thus a representative from Budgewoi gets to vote on whether money is spent in Killcare and vice-versa. The last thing we would want to see is parochialism in the orderly functioning of Council, yet we would wish to see informed and diligent representation made in our interests as matters arise.

Finally, and on a positive note, you may have noticed the fresh landscaping near the Surf Club Kiosk. We are still waiting on the new wheelchair accessible picnic table to be installed but the pathway and new grass looks fabulous. This work is funded through WTKCA by the estate of the late Fay Gunther who loved this area and helped Helena Taylor at the kiosk to lobby for improvement over many years. We are delighted it has come to fruition with their support. Mike Allsop

THE BOUDDI ART SHOW—WAGSTAFFE HALL OCTOBER LONG WEEKEND— 5TH AND 6TH OCTOBER


