President's Notes February 2025

Happy New Year to our community at large – a bit late maybe but this is our first chance for Talking Turkey to extend our best wishes. A lot has been happening since our last edition circulated in early December, and Christmas is only the half of it.

Firstly, Wagstaffe Hall has had a full kitchen renovation, timed perfectly to run late and to give concern to those who booked family events over the season. All was well in the end pleasingly. Finishing works (eg tiling and painting) are still to come but all will be sorted by mid-February with any luck. There is no disruption to regular bookings. This has been funded by a combination of a NSW Government grant and application of WTKCA reserves, about 50% each. The old kitchen had served for nearly 20 years and we hope this new one will serve for a long time as well. It is a great asset for the community and makes the hall a very attractive venue.

Then the power went out across Killcare and surrounds. As it turns out, Wagstaffe and half of Pretty Beach are served by underground cable from Ettalong which seems much less susceptible to disruption than the supply coming over the hill. These areas remained unaffected by the extended outage. As part of the Bouddi Community Resilience Plan, whenever something like this happens, we open Wagstaffe Hall for anyone who needs to charge devices, tools etc. We even provide free wifi while you wait. We did say no, you can't look to top up your EV though! We were pleased that many in our wider community were able to drop by for assistance, informed either by word of mouth or Facebook through mobile internet. Those without mobile service were completely cut off, lending weight to our campaign for the mobile tower proposal on Wards Hill Rd to proceed. Lucky we were not cut off by fire at the time.

The mobile tower proposal is under review at present, with Council, Optus and Gordon Reid's office meeting to try to find a way through the recent rejection. Fingers crossed. It has been re-opened for comment, so if you would like to make a submission, it is Ref DAR/3623/2022/A at address 37 Wards Hill Road. 
